HOOK GREEN ROAD, SOUTHFLEET

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Hook Green Road, Southfleet will be closed to through traffic, on or after 29th September 2025 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed Between junction of Station Road (B262) and Westwood Road.

The alternative route is via Dale Road Station Road (B262), Betsham Road (B262), Highcross Road (B255) (vice versa).

It is planned that the road will be closed between 10:00 hrs and 14:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
