#### TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Shearwater, Longfield will be closed to through traffic, on or after 17th September 2025 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed From the junction of Nuthatch to no63.

The alternative route is via Nuthatch, Turnstone, Vice Versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 07:00 hrs and 16:30 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable Carry out urgent carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
